CPS high school seniors who graduate with a 3.0 GPA and who test completion-ready in math and English are able to pursue a degree or certificate at City Colleges at no cost—free tuition and books.

What Does the Scholarship Cover?

City Colleges will provide waivers for all tuition and books not covered by financial aid.



Who Is Eligible for this Program?

City Colleges will provide this free college opportunity for Chicago Public High School graduating seniors who meet these academic requirements:

- 1) Graduates from a CPS high school with a 3.0 or higher GPA, on a 4.0 scale
- 2) Enrolls in one of the City Colleges' academic pathways*
- 3) Earns an ACT score of 17 or better in English and math, or an SAT score of 460 in writing and 440 in math (if SAT is taken before March 1, 2016, 410 in writing and 400 in math), indicating the student is completion-ready.

This includes undocumented students, international students and students at CPS charter high schools.

* French Pastry School excluded.



How Long Is the Scholarship Good for?

CPS graduates will have up to three years to use the funds starting in the first fall semester after their CPS graduation.



What Is Completion-Ready?

Completion-ready means a student's test scores indicate he or she can take courses leading to college-level coursework and earn an associate degree within three years of enrolling at City Colleges.



Steps to Apply

- 1) Check the STAR application box while completing the City Colleges Online Admissions Application or submit a scholarship application through the STAR Online Application if you have already applied to CCC.
- 2) Fill out and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or fill out the STAR Scholarship Certification of Ineligibility to File for Financial Aid form, if unable to file a FAFSA. If a student is eligible to file a FAFSA, all financial aid verification processes must be complete and financial aid award package must be processed.
- 3) Complete consent section (or decline to share your student data with four-year colleges and universities that offer STAR Scholars transfer scholarships after completing at CCC) through the student portal.

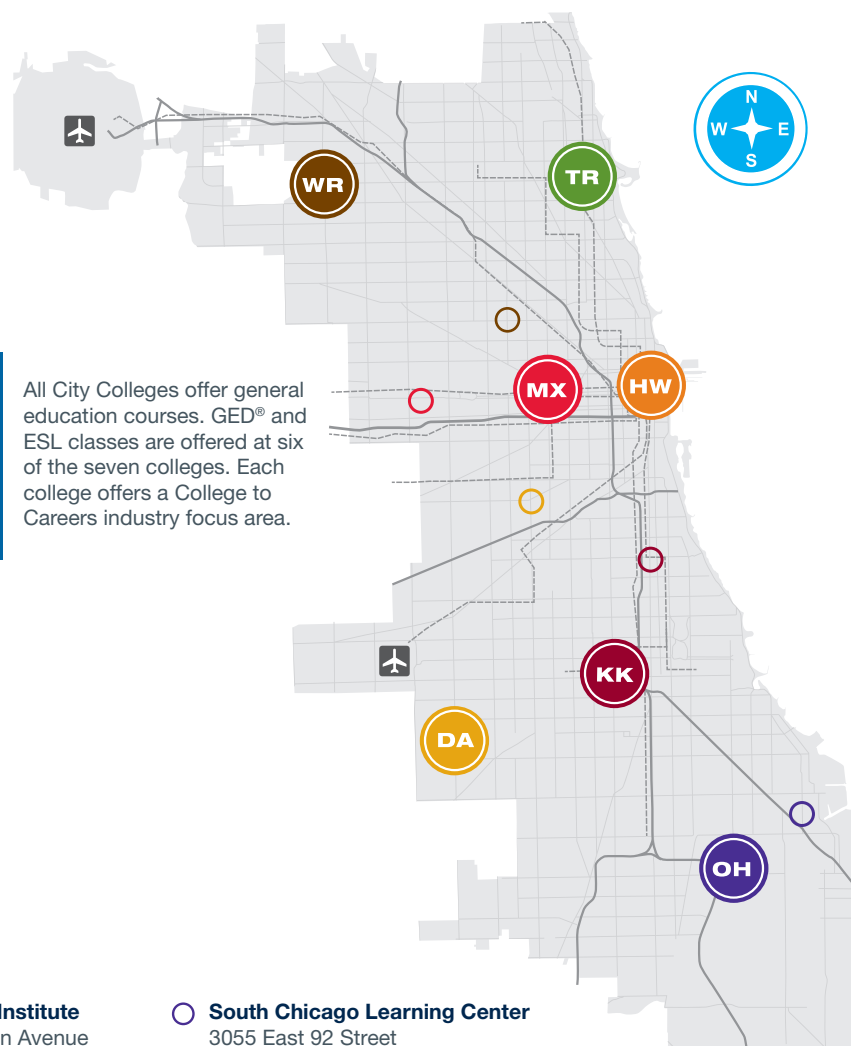
