Practice-Informed Social Work

The Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) at Loyola University Chicago prepares students for entrance into the social work profession as beginning level generalists in a variety of settings. **Graduates of the BSW program at Loyola can then choose to complete one additional academic year* to earn their Master of Social Work (MSW) degree**. The MSW experience increases mobility and gives a broader range of job prospects. Loyola social work students can expect to be prepared for careers in social services, including child welfare, community mental health, drug/alcohol rehabilitation, migration studies, and more.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- · Minimum 2.50 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- · Complete online application and submit transcripts
 - If transcripts are unofficial, the student will be conditionally admitted and may not enroll in courses until
 official transcripts are received.
- AA/AS generally covers all Core classes with the exception of 2–3 mission-related courses

CURRICULUM

- 38 credit hours at the Generalist/Foundation level
- 15 credit hours are required for social science courses
- Courses can be covered by your AA/AS with CCC
- BSW requirements

MSW

Once a Loyola student graduates with their BSW, they can choose between the following:

- the advanced year of the MSW (full-time or part-time)
- the Online MSW (part-time)
- the Online Bilingual MSW (part-time)

All advanced year options are a total of 23 credit hours to complete.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR BSW GRADUATES

- Minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Complete free online application

- BSW graduates can choose between two specializations and then a respective track:
 - Micro Practice
 - Advanced Clinical Practice (MSW/OMSW)
 - Certified Alcohol & Other Drugs Counselor Training Program—CADC (MSW)
 - Migration Studies (MSW/OBMSW)
 - School Social Work/Professional Educator License—PEL (MSW/OMSW)
 - Leadership, Mezzo, & Macro Practice (MSW/OMSW)
