Requirements:

1. Students must have taken all of the CTE courses below and have at least a “C” or better in each course.
2. Student must be eligible for English 101.
3. Students must meet any additional general education pre-requisites for the articulated course.
4. Student must attach a copy of the student’s official transcript to the Articulation Agreement Credit Award Form and submit it to the CCC admissions representative.
5. The agreement pertains to CPS students that successfully complete their CTE program by July 2023.
6. The agreement is valid for 2 years following the student’s graduation date.
