Chicago Public Schools and City Colleges of Chicago have an articulation agreement for the **Entrepreneurship Program**. Students may earn up to **6 college credits** toward their college degrees earned at City Colleges of Chicago if they maintain a "C" or better in each of the high school CTE classes and pass the W!SE Financial Literacy exam with 75% or higher. Students will receive advanced standing credit upon their full admission to a City College of Chicago Campus in the relevant degree programs listed below.

## **Requirements:**

- 1. Students must have taken all of the CTE courses below and have at least a "C" or better in each course.
- 2. Students must be eligible for English 101 and Math 118 (or higher).
- 3. Students must meet any additional general education pre-requisites for the articulated course.
- 4. Student must attach a copy of the student's official transcript to the Articulation Agreement Credit Award Form and submit it to the CCC admissions representative.
- 5. The agreement pertains to CPS students that successfully complete their CTE program by July 2023.
- 6. The agreement is valid for 2 years following the student's graduation date.
