Campus Lab Discussions

Eddie Phillips: Discussed Campus Labs; securing a tool for data analysis and reporting, student-level data (Campus labs); understand how to use platform; discussed assessment model types (juried, communication) pros/cons and what would be the best option that the platform provides

Darby Johnsen: What do we want from Campus Labs?

- Have artifacts submitted with student identifying information tied to the artifact.
 - Maybe the instructor tags the artifact with the student ID number on submission
 - Potential column also for SLO (drop-down for ILOs)
- Reviewers only see the artifact; not the other reviewer’s score (seeing the ID number isn’t an issue)
- Multiple reviewers of a single artifact using a common rubric (can be simultaneous)
 - Can examine inter-rater reliability.
- Automated workflow functionality.
- Would like:
- Potential for customized reminders
