



FERPA Privacy Policy

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) affords eligible students certain rights with respect to their education records, including the right to access your education records, the right to seek to have the records amended, the right to have control over the disclosure of personally identifiable information from the records, and the right to file a complaint with the US Department of Education. An “eligible student” under FERPA is a student who is 18 years of age or older or who attends or previously attended a postsecondary institution.
