Maintain a minimum Cumulative GPA based on Attempted Credit Hour as follows:

1-15	1.5
16-30	1.75
31 or more	2.0

Meeting Cumulative Pace of Completion based on Attempted Credit Hours as follows:

1-15	50%
16-30	60%
31 or more	67%

Attempting no more than 150% of the credits required for completion of your degree or certification:

FACTORS THAT AFFECT MAXIMUM TIMEFRAME

- Credit hours attempted for which the student did not receive financial aid that are applicable toward the current program of study
- Transfer credit hours that are applicable toward the current program of study
- Grade Designations of A, B, C, D, or F
- Academic Dishonesty Withdrawal (ADH)
- Administrative Removal from College (ADR)
- Administrative Withdrawal (ADW)
- Change of Academic Program
- Incomplete Courses
- Repeated Courses
- Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory Grades
- Subsequent Degrees/ Certificates
- Voluntary Medical Withdrawal (VMW)
- Withdrawn (WTH)

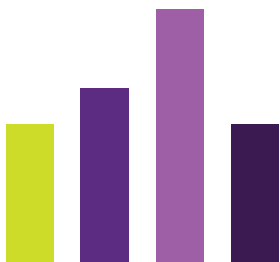

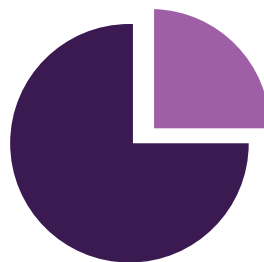
To possibly regain financial aid eligibility, students must complete the appeal process. Below is the QR code to complete the SAP appeal process:
