3) Lauren Daley, Director of the Access Center

-Discuss what we are doing, in terms of accessibility and assessment -Lauren to discuss the ways in which the Access Center is working on accessibility in assessment

- To date, the access center hasn't had much impact on accessibility in assessment.
- Usually when we think about accessibility, we think about students that are blind or have low vision. Is the assessment compatible with a screen reader?
- Another thing to think about is whether this assessment is accessible for students with learning differences?
- The Assessment Committee already used the reading calculator to identify the level of reading the questions each were.
- It's always better to offer a paper version for some students. This can be offered in the Access Center.

- Students could come to the Access Center to take the assessment. (students need documentation in order to receive an accommodation)
- Lauren could look to see if JAWS would work with Qualtrics. Katie thinks that Qualtrics does, but we still need to look into it. The graphs will rely on the text descriptions created. Lauren will also review these.
- Qualtrics is currently set to not allow students to go back. Jen will be editing this feature.

- Read her part of the checklist that we are working on for instructors. Part of which has reminders about accessibility.
- Closed caption—the Access Center can create closed captions for all videos (universal design for all learners)
- An accessibility committee has been formed from a district-wide plan. It is currently on hold. We are also awaiting the district approval of neurodiversity coordinator.
- Lauren is willing to create a professional development opportunity for faculty to get support with making their Brightspace page accessible.
