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HWC Assessment Committee

The Assessment Committee at Harold Washington College is an interdisciplinary group composed of faculty, professional and clerical staff, students, and administrators who collect, review, analyze, and disseminate data on the educational experiences of the college community in an effort to maintain high standards for learning quality and, ultimately, improve student learning.

At HWC, assessment takes place at a range of levels, from the individual classroom through to the institution as a whole. The Assessment Committee meets weekly during the fall and spring semesters and is charged with the assessment of the college's seven general education goals and their specific student learning outcomes. Additionally, the Assessment Committee assesses student engagement to provide more general data about the student experience at HWC.
