After a busy and productive week, I am delighted to share with you highlights of our progress on several key initiatives. We are making significant progress with our recruitment and hiring of key college positions. I want to take this opportunity to thank all of the committee members for their participation and engagement in these searches. I also want to thank the leadership team for taking additional responsibilities to assist these areas.

I am also very pleased to share that we are moving forward with the creation of our Undocumented Student Resources. This initiative will be housed in the Dean of Students office lead by Associate Dean Patricia Cuevas. This project will focus on individual support for undocumented students, training for faculty and staff, programming, and strengthening partnerships with community-based organizations and immigration experts. We are currently seeking faculty, student and staff to serve as advocates and to join the planning group. If you are interested, please reach out to Associate Dean Cuevas.

This week I had the pleasure of meeting with many of you, including Faculty Council leadership, Admissions, and Testing staff. I also had the opportunity to meet with Bank of America to discuss the implementation of our TechQuity partnership and with National Louis University to discuss transfer pathways for our students. In addition, I participated in the monthly Illinois Council on Community College Presidents (ICCCP) meeting to discuss how to increase access for early childhood educators.
