

### Estimated Program Costs for 2024-2026

The costs listed below are typical expenses undertaken in the Occupational Therapy Assistant program two-year AAS degree program for those students who reside within the city limits of Chicago. Tuition costs for students living out of district are substantially higher and may be referenced in the current Wright College online catalog.
