

## **Graduate Performance**

### **Certification Examination**

Graduates of the Wright College Occupational Therapy Assistant Program are eligible to sit for the certification examination offered by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy, Inc. (NBCOT). NBCOT reports examination performance scores of new graduate exam takers. The three most recent new graduate exam taker years (2020, 2021, 2022) are indicated below:

### **AGGREGATE PASS RATE**

Between 2020-2022 the Occupational Therapy Assistant Department graduated 58 students who became eligible to take the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT) examination. Fifty students have taken the NBCOT exam. The total number of graduates who passed the certification exam as new graduate test takers from 2020-2022 was 45 out of 50 which resulted in an average pass rate of 91.3%.
